The contest will be judged by a panel of judges and will be open to the public. In general, contestants will be judged on their knowledge, articulation, poise, and the contestant's ability to "tell the beef production story" and present the industry in a positive light.

The contest will consist of a written response, a personal interview, and a prepared 5-7 minute speech of their choice on a topic or question regarding the beef industry. Contestants will be scored on their ability to thoughtfully identify misinformation, list positive consumer information and answer questions. Speeches should be created for the consumer, not someone in the cattle industry.
